**ELIZABETH A. NAPOLI COMPLETES ASSIGNMENT AS INTERIM PRESIDENT OF  
FOUNDATION FOR FREE ENTERPRISE**

Elizabeth A. Napoli, President of MC & M Ltd. has completed a four-month assignment as the Interim President of the Foundation for Free Enterprise (FFFE), a non-profit educational foundation located in Paramus, New Jersey. Ms. Napoli, a long-time volunteer and former Chairman of the organization, assumed the role as Interim President in mid-February. Her primary assignments were to find a new president for the organization and to coordinate the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Luncheon for the Foundation for Free Enterprise. Ms. Napoli coordinated the very successful FFFE 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Luncheon that was held on June 12 at the Stony Hill Inn in Hackensack, New Jersey. The event included the induction of Joseph T. Dockery, President of Prestige Motors, Inc., into the FFFE Free Enterprise Hall of Fame, the honoring of Margaret Collins as Teacher of the Year and the awarding of the B. Franklin Reinauer Essay Contest Award to Joseph Dabbs, a senior at Leonia High School. More than 350 business executives, civic leaders and educators were on hand to recognize the honorees for their outstanding contributions. The luncheon raised over \$140,000 which will go to support programs presented by the Foundation for Free Enterprise.
